**COSHOCTON, Ohio** – The second installment of the Civil War Lecture Series at Historic Roscoe Village will be held at 2pm on Sunday, June 19 in the Visitor Center Theater.

*Mr. Lincoln's Camera Man: An Afternoon with Mathew Brady* will be presented as a portrayal by Mark Holbrook, Marketing Manager for the Ohio Historical Society. Holbrook is a native Ohioan, a graduate of the Ohio State University and an avid student of history. He has been a Civil War reenactor for over 15 years and has given

numerous lectures to children and adults about the life of a Civil War soldier. An author of several articles on the Civil War and reenacting, Mark is the editor of the soon-to-be published regimental history of the 49<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry. In addition to overseeing the Society's marketing, Mark portrays historic characters for Society events, and acts in the Echoes in Time theatre series at the Ohio Historical Center in Columbus.
