**COSHOCTON, Ohio** – If you’re looking for a way to give back to your community this summer while gaining useful experience, the Landscape Department at Roscoe Village is offering such an opportunity.

From now through mid-September, volunteers will meet with members of the Landscape Department at the Landscape House across from COTC every Thursday from noon until

2pm. They will circuit the village as a “gardening group”, learning how to prune ivy and shrubs, dig and divide plants, thin and care for plants, dry flowers, plus the varied traits of soil and growing condition - and of course there will be the inevitable weeding!

Education is a fundamental characteristic of Roscoe Village, and through hands-on experience the Landscape Department is extending this volunteer program to help the community learn a few things in addition to the historical aspects of the village – like giving back, taking pride in your community ... and your basic plant care.

The group will work on different areas of the village in order to gain a total learning experience as they tend perennials, shrubs, trees and ground coverings. If it’s a rainy day, everyone will work on indoor projects. Volunteers are asked to bring their own pruners, kneeling pads, and water bottles.
